Make Snow

For those who don't have snow outside, try making non-melting "snow" for your indoor tactile play time. Pack together some snowballs and make a Frosty the Snowman friend!





MAKE SNOW

Mix 1-1/2 cup baking soda and 1/3 cup white hair conditioner in a bowl. This cool and soft mixture can be pressed into molds or rolled into balls. For reuse, store in an air-tight container. If it's dry when you go to reuse, add conditioner or water.

Pack the "snow" into molds and cookie cutters. Make a snowman, penguin or your favorite animal. How about a snow dinosaur?!

BUILD A SNOWMAN

Roll three snow balls: small for head, medium for torso, and large for the lower body. Stack them with smallest snow ball on top.

Add features:

Face: carrot, beads, buttons Scarf: fabric (and pin for securing) Arms: stiff twine or small twigs

Top hat: scissors, paper and glue (school glue or glue gun)
